At NSU, we have a dynamic learning environment that empowers students to become future leaders. We view sustainability not just as a concept but as a way of life. Preserving natural resources, maintaining environmental cleanliness, and acting with a sense of social responsibility are among our university's top priorities.

Currently, Nakhchivan State University employs 524 professors and teachers across 43 departments. The faculties include one academic, five corresponding members of the Azerbaijan National Academy of Sciences, 30 doctors of science, 19 professors, 183 doctors of philosophy, and 140 associate professors. Among the academic staff, there are notable figures such as a People's Artist, an Honored Scientist, 10 Honored Teachers of the Republic of Azerbaijan, 3 Honored Artists of the Republic of Azerbaijan, and 4 Honored Culture Workers of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

Additionally, the faculty includes 32 Honored Teachers of the Nakhchivan Autonomous Republic, 5 Honored Artists, 2 Honored Physical Education and Sportsmen, 2 Honored Doctors, and 5 Honored Cultural Workers. Many faculty members have received various honorary titles for their contributions to their respective fields.

LMQ-S Project Report

Introduction

This report is an overview of different educational and developmental activities within Nakhchivan State University under the LMQ-S project. The purpose of the LMQ-S project involves multiple approaches to improving a students' knowledge about health care. This report presents main events, including “Healthy Camp” project, risk management training in health care system, quality assurance training in healthcare services and creation of a new specialty in healthcare management. These programs provided a foundation for preparing future professionals who will excel in their careers and make significant contributions towards improvement of health sector.

Healthy Camp Project at Batabat

The students' visit to Batabat was organized as part of the "Healthy Camp" project, facilitated by the Student Trade Union Committee in collaboration with the Faculty of Medicine. The visit commenced with an introduction to the flora and fauna of Zangezur National Park, located in the Shahbuz region. Following this, a training session focused on researching and studying medicinal plants around Batabat Lake was conducted. Subsequently, medical faculty students led training sessions on various first aid procedures, including:



- First aid in case of clinical death
- First aid for suffocation due to a foreign body
- First aid for shock and coma

During these sessions, participants' questions were addressed comprehensively. Additional training sessions covering topics such as:

- First aid for bleeding
- First aid for poisoning
- First aid for burns
- First aid for fractures, sprains, and dislocations were also conducted.

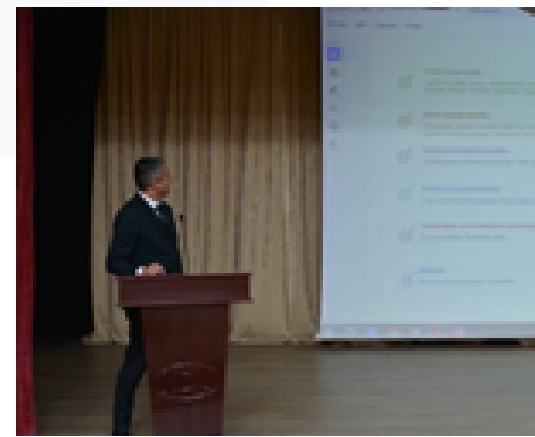
Quality Assurance Training
